

Reading

Many of the children will have brought home their first books from the library in a while. They have been assigned a reading level known as a Zone of Proximal Development (ZPD). This has been arrived at by assessing their reading through a bespoke test. Children are asked to read within this ZPD as the vocabulary and complexity of the story are at the correct level.

All pupils will be retested every 6 weeks when you should then see an improvement in their reading and possibly a change to their ZPD. Every time they finish a book from the library they will complete a mini test called a quiz that will check that they have understood what they are reading.

The more pupils read and quiz, the more accurate a picture the system gains of children's reading habits.

The information we gather includes how many productive minutes of reading they are completing daily, how many words they read, and the level of their understanding of the vocabulary within the book.

Please be patient with the new library arrangements and your children as they settle into using this system. We will set reading targets for all pupils in the new year.

This is a fantastic system and gives the school a very clear picture of your child's skills as well as future development as a reader.

School Census

School Census day is <u>Thursday 18th January 2018</u>, and on this day the school uploads data to the Local Authority which brings funding in to the school budget.

Anyone who is in receipt of certain benefits and earns below £16,190 per annum could be eligible to claim free school meals and pupil premium (this is not to be confused with the Universal Infant Free School Meals which does not receive funding).


