Home Learning

1. **Reading** - daily and for an increasingly longer duration. This should involve thinking, talking, predicting and questioning what they have read as well as relating it to other reading or life experiences.
2. **Times Tables** - rehearsing all the times tables in order to increase their fluency. The children will refer to these regularly in school as they apply them in their maths lessons.
3. **English task** - this will be set through their work books and relate to 'spelling, punctuation and grammar'.
4. **Maths task** - this will focus on a specific area of maths that they are learning or have learnt.
