Your child has been issued with a home-school learning diary which needs to be brought in to school each day alongside their reading book. If you wish to communicate with us, please write a note in the 'home' side of the diary. If there is a message, the children have been told to put diaries on the teachers' desk, so please let your child know if you have written in their diary.

<u>The Waves Team</u>

<u> PE</u>

Home Learning

<u>Reading</u>

Please continue with reading each night. By Year 4 and 5, I would expect the children to be reading and talking about reading for increasingly longer periods. In the front of home-school diaries, the children have an outline of reading expectations. It is encouraging to read all of the positive comments that you write in the home-school diary as the aim is for the children to enjoy their reading. I also encourage them to write in their diary as well. We have now completed Accelerated Reader assessments and they have chosen reading books that are within their current reading range. The children must only read books that are on the programme and within reading range.

Target Setting

In the home-school diaries, you will notice stickers with reading and times table targets. These have been set alongside the children and are short, achievable targets. This is supported in class with a target display to celebrate successes. Please support the children to practice and achieve these at home.
