To commemorate the marriage of Prince Harry to Meghan the school had a Red, White and Blue non-uniform day last Friday (with games for children in the afternoon).

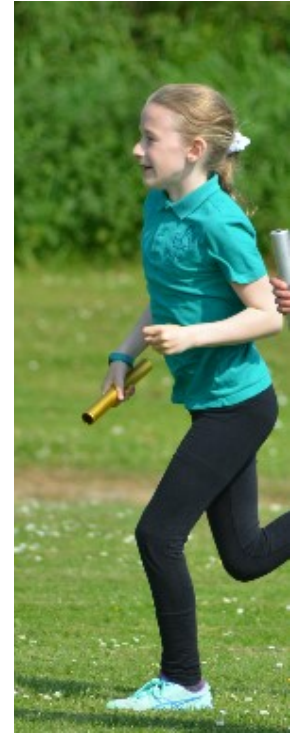

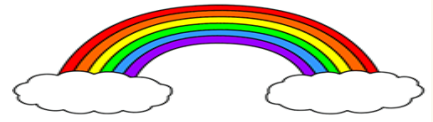
