


Mullion CP News



Attendance

Mullion C. P. School works closely with the Educational Welfare Officer who advises us on our approach to attendance. It is clear that the attendance rates at school are well below the expected national averages. I must stress the importance of good attendance at school. Whilst we do not wish families to send children to school when they are ill, we would urge parents to be aware of the importance of regular attendance. In the past schools have been able to be more lenient and grant a number of days within the school year. This is no longer the case and we cannot authorise absence unless there are exceptional circumstances or illness. Exceptional circumstances would be characterised as unavoidable or one off situations. Currently the school's attendance rates are 93%, this is significantly lower than expected, the national average is 96%. Bildute
