Children in Need Friday 17th November ~ Non Uniform with a 'Spotty' theme. No cakes, just a donation.

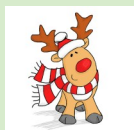

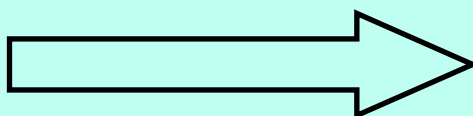
## School Keep Clear Markings
