All concerns relating to child protection should be shared with the DSL in the first instance or, in their absence, the Deputy DSL.

If a disclosure is made and the DSL and Deputy DSL are not available, staff should contact the Multi Agency Advice Team Practitioner Consultation Line on 0300 123 1116. If there is evidence of <u>actual harm or the risk of harm</u> to a child, the Multi Agency Referral Unit [MARU] should be contacted <u>without delay</u> on 0300 123 1116.

Allegations against members of staff should be reported to the Headteacher immediately. Allegations against the Headteacher should be reported to the Safeguarding Governor. Concerns about the conduct of staff should be reported to the Whistleblowing Governor.
